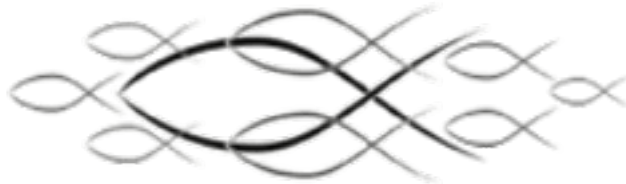


Living Water Emmaus
