COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR

In the New Testament, there are repeated admonitions to give thanks to God. Thanksgiving is to always be a part of our prayers. Some of the most remembered passages on the giving of thanks are the following:

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God" (Philippians 4:6).

"Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men" (1 Timothy 2:1).

Of all of God's gifts, the greatest one He has given is the gift of His Son, Jesus Christ. On the cross of Calvary, Jesus paid our sin debt, so a holy and just Judge could forgive us our sins and give us eternal life as a free gift. This gift is available to those who will call on Christ to save them from their sin in simple but sincere faith (John 3:16; Romans 3:19-26; Romans 6:23; Romans 10:13; Ephesians 2:8-10). For this gift of His Son, the gift which meets our greatest need, the Apostle Paul says, "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!" (2 Corinthians 9:15).

This time of year always bothers me - it seems we skip the real meaning of thanksgiving. We look forward to turkey, football and family time, but we get so busy we forget to thank God for our many blessing.

Let's try something different this year. We need each family in the Living Water Emmaus community to start posting family blessing on the Living Water Emmaus face book page on Thursday October 13th and continue till October 19.th When you post say a short prayer of thanksgiving. For example, Sherry Wall on the 13th could post "Thank you Lord for my family and new daughter in law." Then Sherry and Art can say a prayer of thanksgiving for their family. Then each day for a week she adds a new post to her list.

Then each day when we read all the post of thanksgiving on facebook, if we want to say a short prayer of thanksgiving for any or all post-simply hit like and say a short prayer. We need at least 25 families to join us in claiming 1Timothy 2:1. Then if each family posts at least one prayer of thanksgiving for 7 days and we average 10 likes per post we will lift up over 1500 prayers of thanksgiving in 7 days. The more post the more prayers of thanksgiving.

Then at our November community meeting, we can all thank God together when Kyle Brock brings a special message on Thanksgiving.
