night to the Agape Room.


Agape Gifts - Bring Thursday

table groups.

Instructions to Roaring Springs Camp and Retreat Center from just outside the town of Roaring Springs on Highway 70:

1. Turn EAST on FM 684 E toward County Road 411. Drive 5.5 miles.
2. Turn NORTH (left) onto County Road 414. Drive 1.0 mile.
3. Turn South (right) onto County Road 433. There will be two more camp signs. Follow the signs. Drive 1.4 miles.
4. **Welcome to Roaring Springs Camp and Retreat Center!**

Total Drive Time: 24 minutes (10.2 miles)



Thursday February 4: Send-Off – Will start at ~6:30 PM. Immediately following will be Sponsor’s Hour

Saturday February 6: Candlelight - Do not arrive at the Worship Center before 7:30 PM. Worship service will begin about 8:30 PM. Pilgrims are scheduled to arrive at 10 PM.

Sunday February 7: Closing - Do not arrive at the Worship Center earlier than 3:30 PM. Worship service will begin about 4:30 PM, with the pilgrims scheduled to arrive between 4:45 and 5:00 PM. Volunteers are needed to help with cleanup after closing.
