
Living Water Emmaus May 2021

Notice in these words "before I formed you in the womb." Life does not begin at birth; life begins at conception. That is when God starts weaving us together in our mother's wombs. God said, "I formed you in the womb." But even before then, God knew you. That word "know" in Hebrew refers to the intimate relationship between a husband and wife. God was saying, "I had a relationship with you before I even began forming you. And not only have I formed you and known you, but I have consecrated you." That means God has set you apart for a great purpose. What was true for Jeremiah is true for you. God has not only made you, but He has set you apart for a great, eternal purpose."
