I always love telling the story of Elijah and his showdown with the Baal Prophets, especially the part where he taunts them and asks them "is your God on the toilet?" (children always love that part!). Elijah trusted God and God provided. I want to share the commentary from my Bible from 1 Kings 19: 3-18.

"Elijah experienced the depths of fatigue and discouragement just after his two great spiritual victories: the defeat of the prophets of Baal and the answered prayer for rain. Often discouragement sets in after great spiritual experiences, especially those requiring physical effort or involving great emotion. To lead him out of depression, God first let Elijah rest and eat. Then God confronted him with the need to return to his mission—to speak God's words in Israel. Elijah's battles were not over; he still had work to do. When you feel let down after a great spiritual experience, remember that God's purpose for your life is not yet over."

This was a great reminder to me of exactly what we experience after a Walk to Emmaus. We are either part of the team that puts many hours of work in, or we are a Pilgrim experiencing great emotion (the team also experiences this too). When we leave that Holy place where God has spoken to us, and we really listened and felt His presence, we are exhausted but on a great high. As days and weeks pass, we may begin to lose focus on what God has done and is doing in our lives and go right back into that pit. God





lets us rest, but still requires us to remember that He has a special purpose for each of us. This is one reason Emmaus desires to build up the church and encourages each of us to be active in our local church. Get involved and use your unique gifts to further His I love what Deetress Peoples shared with us at Community last month; "When I start getting depressed and doubting, I reach out to my sisters, and they lift me up. Always remember your sisters are there for you!" This is what Emmaus is, a community of uplifters and prayer warriors.
